A LETTER FROM OUR CEO





At Anchorage Neighborhood Health Center, 2022 saw us emerge from the worst days of the pandemic with a strengthened commitment to accessible health care for everyone in our community. Although we are gradually resuming normal operations, some pandemic-related changes, like an emphasis on telehealth, remain in place. We are proud that in 2022, telehealth accounted for 7% of our 36,710 patient visits.

In the past year, ANHC has also invested in new tools and projects that have increased our patients' access to their health care. In the spring, we launched a new integrated and streamlined electronic health record

system. While in the short term this change slowed our data collection capacity, it is already benefitting patients enormously in terms of community connectivity, access, and whole health. In the summer, we completed an extensive pharmacy renovation project, installed new wayfinding signage throughout our building, and launched a new external website. The year ended on a delicious note, with a gift from a generous donor enabling us to present bags of oranges to our patients as they visited our campus.





2022 PATIENT DEMOGRAPHICS




